

ARTICLE V
Continuance of Legislation; Penalties

§ 171.34. Effect on prior legislation and legal actions.

The provisions of this Part 1, so far as they are the same as those of ordinances and regulations in force immediately prior to the enactment of this Part 1, are intended as a continuation of such ordinances and regulations and not as new enactments. The provisions of this Part 1 shall not affect any act done or liability incurred, nor shall they affect any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted to enforce any of these repealed ordinances or regulations.

§ 171.35. Overtime parking violations.

For the purposes of assessing penalties and fines under this Part 1, the violations of Article III, §§ 171.26 and 171.27, and Article IV, § 171.30, and Article III, § 171.28, where penalties are expressly prescribed under this Part 1, shall be interpreted as overtime parking violations.

§ 171.36. Violations and penalties. [Amended 8-10-01 by Ord. No. 929]

171.36.1. The penalties and fines for violations of this Part 1 shall be as set forth in the VEHICLE CODE of 1976, as amended¹ except as to Article II, § 171.6, and Article III, §§ 171.23 through 171.27, and Article IV, § 171.30, and certain expressed exceptions to Article III, § 171.28.

171.36.2. The penalty for violation of Article II, § 171.6; Article III, §§ 171.23, 171.24, 171.25, 171.26 and 171.27; and Article IV, § 171.30 shall be a fine of ten dollars (\$10.) if paid to the BOROUGH within five (5) days; and if not paid within five (5) days, a summons will be issued by the District Justice at the request of any police officer, and upon summary conviction, the fine will be fifteen dollars (\$15.) plus costs. The penalty for violation of Article III, § 171.28, insofar as Schedule XVIII prescribes a penalty under this Part 1, shall be as set forth above in this section.
