Districts

§ 180.5. Classification of districts. [Amended 3-16-83 by Ord. No. 659¹; amended 7-17-08 by Ord. No. 1011]

For the purpose of this chapter, the BOROUGH is hereby divided into classes of districts which will be designated as follows:

Civic Districts	C-1

§ 180.6. Zoning Map. [Amended 3-16-83 by Ord. No. 659]

The boundaries of said districts shall be shown upon the Zoning Map. The Zoning Map shall be kept on file at the office of the BOROUGH and shall be available for public examination at such office during the hours it is open for business, except that such Zoning Map may be

removed from such office for any reasonable purpose upon the order of the COUNCIL or the BOARD or upon the joint order of their respective President and Chairman.

§ 180.7. Interpretation of district boundaries.

The boundaries between districts are, unless otherwise indicated, either the center line of STREETS, roads, alleys or railroad rights-of-way, or such lines extended or lines parallel thereto, or the side or rear lines of LOTS of unsubdivided acreage. Where figures are shown on the Zoning Map between a STREET, road, alley or railroad right-of-way and a district boundary line, they indicate that the district boundary line runs parallel to the STREET, road, alley or railroad right-of-way line at a distance therefrom equivalent to the number of feet so indicated.
