#### **§14.1. Adoption of plan.**

The Civil Defense Operations Plan approved by the Board of County Commissioners for Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, on October 30, 1962, and described as "Civil Defense Operations Plan, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, April, 1962," is hereby adopted as the Civil Defense Operations Plan for the Borough of Whitehall.

#### **§14.2. Authority and duties of Director.**

The duly appointed Civil Defense and/or Emergency Management<sup>1</sup> Director for the Borough of Whitehall is hereby authorized and directed to execute for and on behalf of the Borough of Whitehall all required agreements, applications, certificates, claims and documents relating to federal and state aid programs for civil defense involving either financial assistance or the furnishing of emergency equipment, materials, supplies and services.

#### **§14.3. Termination of services of Director.**

The authority and duties herein conferred upon the Director of Civil Defense and/or Emergency Management for the Borough of Whitehall remain in full force and effect until

terminated by the Borough Council through a duly enacted ordinance, official notice of which shall be provided in writing to the State Council of Civil Defense at Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, within ten (10) days immediately following the termination date.

**§14.4. Bond to be furnished.**

The Civil Defense and/or Emergency Management Director of the Borough of Whitehall shall furnish to the borough a bond in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.), to be approved by and paid for by the Borough of Whitehall, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties.
