§42.1. Board Created; Membership; Appointment; Terms.

There is hereby created a Board of Library Directors consisting of seven (7) members who are residents of the Borough of Whitehall and who shall serve without compensation. The members of the said Board of Library Directors shall be appointed by the Borough Council, the first members to be appointed in the following manner: Two (2) members are to be appointed for a term of one (1) year; two (2) members are to be appointed for a term of two (2) years; and three (3) members are to be appointed for a term of three (3) years. All appointments to fill the places of those whose terms expire shall be for a term of three (3) years. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired terms. All members shall serve until their successors have been appointed.

§42.2. Organization.

The Board of Library Directors shall organize as soon as may be after appointment by electing a President, Secretary and Treasurer from its membership and such other officers and agents as the Board may deem necessary.

§42.3. Powers and Duties.

The Board of Library Directors shall have all the powers, duties and responsibilities as are prescribed by Act No, 188 of the 1961 session¹ of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, known as the "Library Code," and shall have the further power to adopt such rules and regulations for its own organization and procedure as are necessary and are consistent with the ordinances of the Borough of Whitehall and the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
