## ASSUMPTION OF RISK and WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELATING TO COVID-19

In order to attend and participate in the Summer Recreation Program, each participant must submit completed versions of the Health Declaration Form and this Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability. Participants who have not completed both forms will not be permitted to participate in camp activities until it is received.

The novel coronavirus, or COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious. By signing this Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability, the undersigned, on behalf of themselves and any minor children named above, hereby stipulate and agree:

1. Attending the Summer Recreation Program and participation in the Summer Recreation Program's activities may include possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases, including but not limited to influenza and COVID-19. While compliance with established guidance from regulatory authorities may help to reduce this risk, I understand and agree that campers may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 while attending the Summer Recreation Program and participating in its activities, and that such exposure or infection may result in injury, illness, temporary or permanent disability, and/or death.
2. **I APPRECIATE THE RISKS INVOLVED, AND I KNOWINGLY, VOLUNTARILY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL RISKS AND DANGERS, BOTH KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, OF POTENTIAL OR ACTUAL EXPOSURE TO OR INFECTION OF COVID-19 THAT MAY OCCUR PURSUANT TO ATTENDANCE AT THE SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM AND PARTICIPATION IN PROGRAM ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION THE RISK OF INJURY, ILLNESS, TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT DISABILITY, AND/OR DEATH.**

In accepting these risks, I, on behalf of myself, and my heirs, assigns, and personal representatives, expressly and explicitly release, discharge, waive and covenant not to sue the Borough of Whitehall and its members, officers, directors, agents, managers, employees, contractors, volunteers, and representatives ("Released Parties") from any and all claims, demands, damages, liabilities, losses, and expenses of every kind or nature, including without limitation for illness, injury, temporary or permanent disability, or death, now known or hereinafter known, in connection with attendance at the Summer Recreation Program, and participation in its activities, and including to the fullest extent permitted by law, even if caused by the negligence of any of the Released Parties. ## **SUMMER RECREATION PARENT INFORMATION**

The Whitehall Borough Summer Recreation Staff would like to welcome you and your children to the summer program, under the direction of Hannah Bower and Mara McGrady. The following information provides you with details of our program. Please take a few minutes to read it carefully and feel free to contact us with any questions or concerns.

The parks will be open and staffed by our counselors Monday through Friday from 9am- 1pm beginning Monday, June 21<sup>st</sup> and concluding on Friday, July 30<sup>th</sup>. You **MUST** be a Whitehall resident between the ages of 5-14 to participate. Park locations are Overlook Acres, Frank, Union and Snyder.

Please be advised that program attendance is voluntary. Children are not required to come every day, nor are they required to stay for the whole 4 hours per day. We ask parents to take into consideration that the counselor to child ratio may be quite large at some parks. Please use your own discretion when deciding whether this level of supervision is appropriate for your younger children. If you have restrictions regarding your children's transportation you must inform the counselors on site. Counselors will not be responsible for kids who leave the park site on their own.

On a daily basis the children will participate in a variety of games, sports and crafts. The calendar will highlight the main feature of the day – special events, field trips, etc. and the remainder of the day is filled with miscellaneous activities.

**WEATHER:** Please refer to the Whitehall Borough Recreation Facebook page for information on closures due to weather. It is the most efficient way to inform everyone. In the event of rain, the parks will close. The shelters at each site do not provide adequate protection from rain & storms. With that in mind, if rain/storms develop after the park opens please make arrangements for your child to be picked up as soon as possible. The counselors will remain on site until all children are picked up.

**APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR:** The goal of this program is to provide a fun, safe environment for the children. We fully expect all to respect their counselors and the other children at the park. Inappropriate language, bullying, abuse of park equipment and any type of physical altercations are unacceptable. Please enforce these rules with your children and be advised of the following disciplinary actions: 1st Offense – verbal warning 2nd Offense – phone call 3rd Offense – removal from park

**FOOD & DRINK POLICY:** We encourage each child to bring a water bottle daily. You may also pack a snack or lunch, however for the safety of others we ask that you **DO NOT PACK ANY PEANUT PRODUCTS** due to some severe allergies. Please label all items with your child's name. We will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

## **SPECIAL EVENT DAYS ON THE CALENDAR**

**INTER-PARK PLAY:** Due to COVID-19 and the safety of all participants, there will be NO inter-park play during 2021 Summer Camp Program

**PIZZA DAYS:** We will have a VOLUNTARY pizza day every Wednesday. The cost is \$3 per person and includes 2 slices of pizza, a drink, paper products, and delivery. Counselors must call in the pizza order by 10 am so please be sure to have your child at the park by then if they plan to participate. All counselors that are handling the pizza will be masked and gloved at all times.

**KONA ICE DAYS:** The Kona Ice Truck will visit each park every Monday between 10am-12pm and the last day of camp. If children want to purchase a shaved ice treat they should bring money in an envelope with their name on it. FYI - prices range from \$2-\$5. This is a voluntary activity and a portion of their sales for the summer is donated to the family of our former Assistant Recreation Director, George McCormack, who lost his courageous battle with cancer. In honor of George's memory, this money is donated to his son's scholarship fund.

**JUNIOR OLYMPICS:** Each park will hold a sporting event competition in which the kids will compete in a variety of challenges. The top winners in each event will compete for their park in the finals on the last week of camp. Ribbons will be given to all participants and medals will be awarded to the winners in the finals.

**FIELD TRIPS:** Allegheny Park Rangers presentation on Skins and Skulls will be held at Overlook and Snyder Park. Union will be bused to Overlook and Frank will be bused to Snyder. Please refer to schedule for dates. Permission slip MUST be returned by July 2 for your child to participate. There will be a counselor(s) remaining at the park for those children not participating. The presentation is free of cost. While on the bus the children will be practicing social distancing and masks will be worn at all times.

**FUN DAY AT SNYDER:** Please check our Facebook page (Whitehall Recreation) in regard to how this will be handled due to COVID-19 Guidelines.

We will be introducing new fun things such as Thinking Tuesday, Try Something New Thursday, Scavenger hunt, Cabin Carnival and more.
